



Financial Assistance for Course Accreditation

The Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission (TVEC) is the apex body established under the provisions of the Tertiary and Vocational Education Act no. 20 of 1990 to plan, coordinate and develop the Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) system in Sri Lanka.

The TVEC invites applications for course accreditation from the TVET providers in the private and Non-governmental Organization (NGO) sectors that conduct TVET programs in the occupations listed below. The TVEC will provide financial assistance in the form of a grant to procure machinery, equipment and tools identified as required for course accreditation. The assistance will be for the upgrading of existing courses to meet the standards for course accreditation and not for the commencement of new courses. National Skill Standards and related curriculum are available at the TVEC for the occupations listed below.

Who is eligible?

The training institutions that fulfill following requirements are eligible to apply. The training institutions;

- in the private/NGO sector that are registered with the TVEC.
- that conduct one or more training courses in the occupations listed above.
- that are engaged in provision of TVET for the last 2 years.

Note: Those institutions that have forwarded applications for registration with the TVEC may also apply. The institutions that have already applied for course accreditation need not apply again.

Method of disbursement of financial assistance:

Financial assistance will be provided on cost reimbursement basis to selected institutes to procure machinery, equipment and tools identified as required for accreditation of selected courses.

How to apply?

Application forms for course accreditation and financial assistance could be obtained from the office of the TVEC by calling over or by making a written request. The application forms could also be downloaded from the website of the TVEC www.tvec.gov.lk.

Duly completed application forms along with support documents should be submitted by registered post or hand delivered to reach the Director General of the TVEC on or before 30th June 2007. The Applications received before this date will be considered to award financial grants in this Year. "Application for course accreditation and financial assistance" should be printed on the top left hand corner of the envelope containing the application.
