Who can apply?

- Those who have completed institutional training (CBT) or Enterprise based Training (EBT) at TVEC registered public or private training institutions in NVQ Level 4 in above occupations.
- Those who have not been successful at the written assessment held earlier.
- Those who are willing to obtain NVQ through Recognition of Prior learning (RPL) mode (Shall send applications through NAITA, VTA or DTET).

How to apply?

Applications are called through the TVEC website www.tvec.gov.lk till 30th June 2019. All those private/NGO sector training centres are requested to submit applications through the TVEC website using the institute registration number (P Number) of the institute. Those who are willing to obtain NVQ through RPL should send their applications either through the National Apprentice and Industrial Training Authority (NAITA), the Vocational Training Authority (VTA) or Department of Technical Education & Training (DTET).

Assessment fee

An assessment fee of Rs. 500/= should be paid per course per applicant by the time application details are uploaded to the website. Candidates should not make individual payments to the banks or TVEC. They have to pay the fee to the training institution and then the institution has to make the payment to the TVEC office or can be deposited to **A/C No. 078-1001-72266044** at any branch of the People's Bank in favor of Director General, Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission. An image of the payment receipt should be uploaded to the application portal in the TVEC website.
