## NVQ Circular 06/2021

Director General, Department of Technical Education and Training (DTET). Chairman, National Apprentice and Industrial Training Authority (NAITA) Chairman, Vocational Training Authority (VTA)

Competency-Based Assessment (CBA) for Candidates appear through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) routes

The purpose of this circular is to expedite the process of RPL applications.

## 2. Selection of Assessment Centre

All RPL assessments shall be conducted only at either the following institutes or industry places approved by the TVEC

- i. Training institutes with an accredited course in the relevant occupation/ trade with a "P" Number (e.g. P01/0000) issued by the TVEC.
- ii. Industry places registered through NAITA with an "E" number (e.g. E01/0000) issued by the TVEC

The respective area inspector of NAITA shall recommend the industry place/s and forward the recommendation reports to the TVEC. The TVEC will issue an "E" number to facilitate the assessment

iii. RPL assessment centre with "A" number (e.g. A01/0000) issued by the TVEC.

The officer appointed by the DTET/NAITA/VTA shall recommend the industry place/s and forward the recommendation reports to the TVEC. The TVEC will issue an "A" number to facilitate the assessment.

- 3. Selection of Assessors for Occupations/ Trades which do not have TVEC registered assessors
- a. In case, if there are no registered assessors for occupations/ trades, accept the applications from the candidates and inform the TVEC. The TVEC will register an assessor from the development committee member of the respective National Competency Standard (NCS) and issue a registration number temporarily to facilitate the assessment.



- b. The TVEC will appoint a licensed assessor to facilitate the assessment in addition to the temporarily assigned assessor.
- c. Both pre-assessment and final assessment shall be conducted with the assistance of both the temporary assessor and the licensed assessor. The assessor payment shall be made for both assessments.
