Occupation/ Job description

IT/ Computer support specialist is a person who provides help and advice to computer users and organizations. These specialists either support computer networks or they provide technical assistance directly to computer users.

Duties of the Occupation/Job

- Provide Technical help to non IT computer users
- Pay attention to customers' descriptions of their computer problems
- Verify with customers by raising questions for proper diagnose the problem
- Aware the customers through the recommended problem-solving steps
- Set up or repair computer equipment and related devices
- Train users to work with new computer hardware or software, such as printers, word-processing software, and email
- Provide other team members and managers in the organization with information about what gives customers the most trouble and about other concerns customers have
- Test and evaluate existing network systems
- Perform regular maintenance to ensure that networks operate correctly
- Troubleshoot local area networks (LANs), wide area networks (WANs), and Internet systems
