
Chengdu Agricultural College Delegation visited to Sri Lanka to explore and exchange ideas and opportunities between the countries from 1<sup>st</sup> November to 3<sup>rd</sup> November. During this time, Dr. Janaka Jayalath, Deputy Director General of Sri Lanka Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission and his colleagues received the delegation, and the two sides exchanged views.



At the meeting, Dr. Janaka introduced the development of vocational education in Sri Lanka, and Digital Economy based Vocational Qualifications Framework for Developing Countries (DEVES). The delegation of Chengdu Agricultural College introduced their schools, disciplines and facilities. The two sides reached cooperation consensus on talent cultivation, studying in China through Scholarship arrangement, teacher exchanges, joint educational program, Co-development of DEVES standards, and signed a memorandum of understanding.
